MODERN SLAVERY

Survivors face a number of barriers to finding safe and permanent employment as a result of their exploitation, including: a lack of confidence, job history and interview experience. Bright Future aims to break down these barriers by offering the opportunity of work without the need for a CV or a competitive interview. This accessible route to employment reduces the risk of re-exploitation.
